

## Raffle Intake Form

Thank you for your interest in raising funds for the Alberta Cancer Foundation and creating more moments for Albertans facing a cancer diagnosis.

Raffles in Alberta must follow all rules and regulations put in place by the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (AGLC). To ensure we provide accurate information to AGLC, we require this form to be completed in full. Due to the extensive resources required to apply, create, and reconcile a raffle, there is an expectation of raising \$5,000 per raffle.

The Alberta Cancer Foundation uses the web-based application Rafflebox to host all raffles.

## **TICKET DETAILS**

Price of tickets being sold: The maximum revenue that can be made is 20% of the total prize value. The ticket breakdown should equal that amount. For example, if the total value of the prize(s) is \$4,000, then the maximum revenue generated from the raffle is \$20,000. If the prize(s) value is \$2,000, then the maximum revenue generated from the raffle is \$10,000, and so on.

A single ticket price must be included.
